


Mrs Balmer – Year 4 Teacher

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
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Mrs Sanders – SCITT Student




Mr Walsh – Cover Supervisor




Mrs Minchin - Cleaner

I'm a cleaner in school at St Mark's along with my husband. I really love reading in my spare time and spending time with my grandchildren.


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Mr Minchin- Cleaner
