Dear Parents/ Carers,

Well what a fantastic Half Term we had had at school! I cannot believe another half term has gone by so quickly. The children have been fantastic, engaging well in lessons and showing a positive attitude to their learning. The children have also been working really hard on their personal, social and emotional focus this term of respect. We have had many conversations with the children about what respect looks like: how do children show respect; how do adults show respect and what is mutual respect. The children have been brilliant and have been making an extra effort to show beautiful manners and respect to one another and all members of our school family. A huge well done to all of our children!

Throughout the week, all children across school from Nursery to Year 6, have been reading the story 'The New Neighbours.' They have all had a different English writing outcome linked to the story. I have been shown some absolutely amazing pieces of work and I am so proud of the effort they have put in.

The children in Little Lions' have been exploring the natural environment. They have been practising colour mixing and painting. This week they have also introduced their new wellbeing song, 'Things that make you go mmmmm.' Reception have been working on writing captions and simple sentences using their phonic knowledge. They have been writing independently in provision and we have been really impressed with their effort and outcomes. The children have been really excited to explore the school book of the week. Year 1 have been working really hard on split digraphs in their phonics and complete the 'split digraph challenge'. The children in year two have been looking at word classes in their Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar lessons. It was lovely to hear them discussing the differences between nouns, verbs and adjectives. Years 3 and 4 have become historians this week and have been learning all about the Battle of Hastings. They have been debating what caused the war and the impact that it had on daily life. Children in Upper KS2 have been exploring content, mood, process and form in Art this week. They have been really excited to create their own Mayan pots using the coiling technique.

This week, all of the Early Years team attended a local authority meeting regarding the changes to the Early Years curriculum. Staff found the sessions incredibly informative, and look forward to implementing the new programmes of study next year.
